Certified Stockinette are certified by the Hong Kong Standards and Testing Centre (HKSTC) with the “STC tested” Mark. HKSTC is the first independent, not-for-profit testing, inspection and certification organization in Hong Kong. HKSTC has been dedicated to providing professional, reliable and comprehensive testing and inspection services, and issuing the highest quality reports to ensure compliance with relevant technical and safety requirements while keeping pace with the development of trade and industry. Their laboratories have been accredited to ISO/IEC 17025*.



Certified Stockinette are tested on their linear density, fibre content, yarn strength and bursting strength based on the standards of International Organization for Standardization (ISO), an independent and non-governmental international organization with membership of 162 national standards bodies.

Certified Stockinette are also tested for harmful substances based in Oeko-Tex Standard 100. The result of the inspection made according to Oeko-Tex Standard 100, product class II** for products with direct contact to skin, have shown that Certified Stockinette meets the human-ecological requirements of the standard presently established.

** The OEKO-TEX® tests for harmful substances are fundamentally based on the respective purpose of the textiles and materials. The more intensive the skin contact of a product and the more sensitive the skin, the stricter the human-ecological requirements that need to be complied with. Product Class II are articles that are worn close to the skin.
